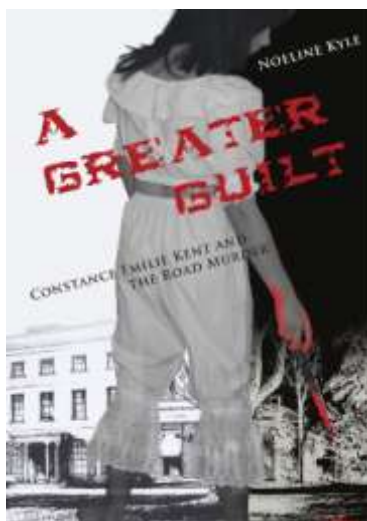


Noeline Kyle's latest book *A Greater Guilt* is a scholarly/popular history where Noeline interrogates the events of the murder of Constance's 3 year-old half-brother in Wiltshire, England in 1860, her confession in 1865 and, linking that brutal past to the later years, writes a fascinating story about Constance Kent's life in prison and her more than 50 years in Australia.

Based on years of historical research Noeline has reconstructed the astonishing events of the Road murder and lives of the Kent family and their descendants - and writes a full and complete biography of Constance Emilie Kent, from her birth in 1844 to her death in 1944. *A Greater Guilt* offers new and controversial conclusions about the perpetrator of the crime, about family secrets, the myths of women's lives and the making up of history.

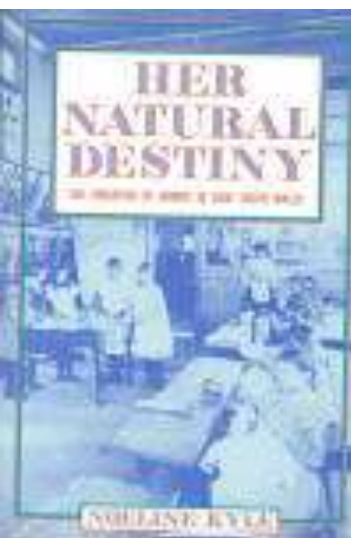
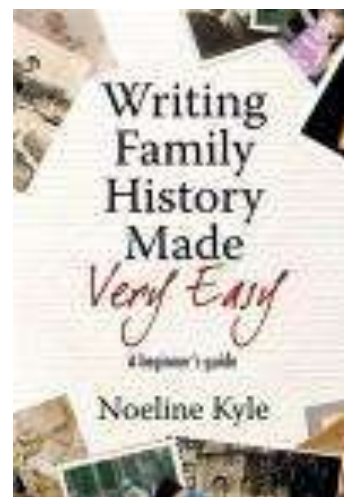

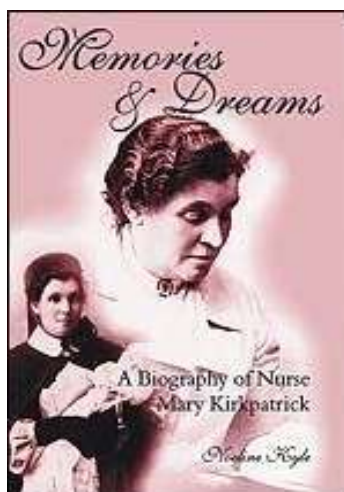

### Her Natural Destiny: The Education of Women in New South Wales

Topics such as the state education of girls, teacher training, technical education, the schooling of girls in religious institutions, industrial and reformatory schools for girls, and an examination of the less prominent private schools are covered in depth and present both a fascinating view of a system designed to channel the energies and creative intelligence of young women into the home. It is also a story of how women and girls slowly challenged the system and the surprising support they often received from female teachers, religious women and their parents.

This is a woman's story, and how women survived independently in country towns.
